Title Meet & Greet First through Third Grades August 4, 2016
What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Students and parents meet their new teacher for the 2016-2017 school year. They are also able to learn about the academic and school environment through the use of Literacy Strategies (Learning Logs and/or Split-Page Note Taking).

Title Falling into Family Literacy October 2016
What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Involve parents in a book study using Thinking Maps and Literacy Strategies as they move with their child(ren) through stations focusing on dissecting the book to learn about story elements.

Title Cooking Up a Math Storm December 2016
